Sessions are from 9.30am to 12 noon on the following dates:

THE COURSE

Tuesday 29th May

Animal Cubism – We will design a drawing using your favourite animal, then using straight lines we will then make it into an exciting cubist painting and colour in using watercolour and acrylic paint and felt pens.

Wednesday 30th May

Jellyfish & Seahorse Suncatcher – Using brightly coloured tissue paper and ribbons, these suncatchers stick to your window to let the sun shine through the transparent layers like a rainbow.

Friday 1st June

Folk Art Still Life – Looking at this style of painting we will design a beautiful bowl of flowers using mixed media, contrasting colours and pattern.

The workshops are aimed at children from the age of 7 upwards who enjoy being creative and imaginative; because numbers are limited in each workshop early booking is advisable.
